Surely, we all remember the Jubilee 2000<sup>th</sup> year of Christianity, whose focus was "Jesus Christ, the only Redeemer of the world yesterday, today and forever". **The figure of St. Anthony is special. He is the servant of the Incarnate Word of the Father.** In this manner, the most popular pictures depict him holding the Gospel book and on it - the Child Jesus.
